

Rules for use of login credentials and network at Konstfack

Login credentials

You are not allowed to share your credentials with anyone else. As the owner of your credentials you are always responsible for any ongoing activity when signed in.

This means that you are held liable for any crimes or other violations that may be associated with your credentials.

Network

The network at Konstfack must never be used:

- In a manner contrary to law or regulation
- To participate in money gambling
- To read, or in any way process, information of violent, racist, pornographic or discriminatory nature other than if it's a part of research or course at Konstfack.

Equipment/programs that is unauthorizedly connected, that affects or otherwise changes/poses risks to other users or infrastructure will be disconnected.

SUNET

The network provider at Konstfack is SUNET. Here are SUNET's ethical requirements for individuals using their network.

SUNET considers it as unethical when someone:

1. Tries to access network resources or other IT resources without having the right to do that
2. Attempts to interfere with or disrupt the intended use of the network or connected IT resources
3. Attempts to damage or destroy computer based information
4. Clearly misuses available resources (personnel, hardware, software)
5. Infringes personal privacy
6. Tries to insult or offend others
