1. Main course content:

In this course, students present their degree projects in the form of an exhibition and a publication, in a reflective and forward-looking way.

2. Intended learning outcomes:

Upon successful completion of the course, the student shall be able to:

- demonstrate an ability to communicate the degree project in a materially and visually well-designed and well-formulated way in the form of an exhibition and a publication.
- demonstrate the relevancy of the degree project to persons with different backgrounds and experience
- demonstrate an ability to reflect on and formulate how the degree project contributes to the development of the subject field.

3. Entry requirements:

Specific entry requirement:

- Bachelor's degree of 180 credits in Interior architecture and furniture design, or equivalent knowledge in the field.
- At least 45 credits from semester 1 and 2 in the master's program Design with specialization Spatial Design, at Konstfack university, or equivalent knowledge in the courses MDE102 Introduction and broadening of perspective and MDE103 In-depth studies in the subject and environment.
- Passed grade in English equivalent to English 6/English B.

4. Grading scale:

The course uses the grading scale Fail (U) or Pass (G).

5. Forms of examination:

The modules are assessed through presentations of artefacts, reports in seminars and written reports.

The examiner is responsible for providing the grading criteria for the examination, and for these to be published on the intranet.

Students who receive the grade Fail (underkänd) in an examination are entitled to take a further five tests as long as the course is given, in order to achieve the grade Pass (godkänd). Students who fail an examination twice by an examiner are entitled to request that another examiner is appointed to decide grades for the test. A request should be made to the Head of Department.

6. Reading list and other study material:

Any course literature will be announced no later than 3 weeks before the course starts and will be presented as an appendix to the course syllabus.

7. Additional Information:

The department is responsible for other essential information, such as detailed teaching methods and grading criteria, to be available for students before the start of the course.

This course may not be credited towards a degree together with similar courses taken and passed, where the content is completely or partly the same as the content of this course.

Students can request to be assessed according to this syllabus no more than twice during a two year period after it has expired.

The course is compulsory and is a part of the master program in Design with specialization Spatial Design.

The course is taught in English.
