1. Main course content:

Introduction to the workshops 2 credits

Own work 28 credits

Introduction to the workshops: introduction to the workshops and machine park and demonstrations and walkthroughs of the techniques, independent work in the workshops based on given information

Independent studies: Independent studio-based work where frames and content is being decided by the student in consultation with responsible teachers.

Produce an exhibition, seminars, study visit, written task assignment

2. Intended learning outcomes:

Introduction to the workshops:

After completion of this stage the student should have an ability to:

- In a safe, effective and environmentally way be able to use machines and equipment in the workshops

Independent studies:

After completed course the student should have an ability to:

- Formulate, plan and produce an independent studio work within the main field of Craft, Ceramic and Glass
- Use relevant method, technique and presentation of the current work
- Discuss their chosen position within the field in relation to their presented artistic work
- Demonstrate an experimental, investigatory and critical reflective approach in relation to their own and other's work
- Complete an independent formulated project for an exhibition context, inclusive of press text and artist statement
- Reflect on an expanded exhibition concept

3. Entry requirements:

General entry requirements.

4. Grading scale:

The course uses the grading scale Fail (U) or Pass (G).

5. Forms of examination:

Examination is being done by supervision and in verbal and physical presentation.

The examiner is responsible for providing the grading criteria for the examination, and for these to be published on the intranet.

Students who receive the grade Fail (underkänd) in an examination are entitled to take a further five tests as long as the course is given, in order to achieve the grade Pass (godkänd). Students who fail an examination twice by an examiner are entitled to request that another examiner is appointed to decide grades for the test. A request should be made to the Head of Department.

6. Reading list and other study material:

The reading list is presented as an appendix to the course syllabus.

7. Additional Information:

The department is responsible for other essential information, such as detailed teaching methods and grading criteria, to be available for students before the start of the course.

This course may not be credited towards a degree together with similar courses taken and passed, where the content is completely or partly the same as the content of this course.
