Once a student has been nominated by their home university, the student will receive an email with application information.

Autumn semester 2026

Nomination and application: 15 March – 15 April

Semester dates August 31, 2026 – January 17, 2027

Obligatory Orientation: August 27 and August 28

Spring semester 2027

Nomination and application period: September 15 – October 15

Semester dates 18 January – 6 June 2027

Orientation meeting: 18 January, 2027

Required documents:

- An application form
- A letter of motivation (1/2 page A4)
- Portfolio: 5-10 pages (A4 size) including pictures, titles, descriptions and descriptive text for each portfolio piece. Please do not send larger portfolios than 10 pages (max 15 MB)
- A CV
- Transcript of records in English, showing the student's academic records from the home university
- Copy of your Passport

Students can expect admission results approximately 6-8 weeks after the application deadline. For students in Fine Art it might take longer due to that the outgoing exchange students from Konstfack need to have their space confirmed first.

Full time studies are 30 credits (30 ECTS credits) per semester. A full-time student is expected to devote approximately 40 hours per week to lectures, seminars and individual studies/work.

Language of instruction

Exchange students at Konstfack are not expected to have any knowledge in the Swedish language. We recommend incoming exchange students to have an advanced English in both speaking as well as reading and writing. For more information [Language requirements - Konstfack](#)

Grading System

The grades used at Konstfack are Pass (G) or Fail (U). The teacher education also has the grade Pass with distinction (VG).

NB! Please note that most courses at Konstfack are assessed as Pass/Fail and it cannot be changed individually for students who need grades (A–F).

Study Programmes open for Exchange students

Department of Crafts

Textiles (BA): Spring semester year 2.

Jewellery and Corpus (BA): Autumn semester and spring semester year 2.

Ceramics & Glass (BA): Autumn semester year 3. Please note that students need to have a background in either the field of ceramics or the field of glass to apply.

Department of Fine Art

Please note that students must have a background in Fine Art to be accepted. If students have another background but their practice within Fine Art, they must make sure to show that in their portfolio and explain it in their motivation letter. Students must be prepared to work individually.

Fine Art (BA): Autumn and spring semester of year 2.

Fine Art (MA): Spring semester of year 1.

Secondary level: Spring semester during third year.

Upper Secondary level: Autumn semester during second year.
